AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking quashing of order dated 8.4.2022 whereby bail bonds of the petitioner have been cancelled, forfeited and arrest warrant issued.

The petitioner was granted bail in case of FIR No. 392 dated 12.9.2018, under Section 384 IPC (Sections 392, 483 and 397 IPC Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 added later on), registered at Police Station Kurukshetra University. He was appearing regularly, however, he failed to appear on 8.4.2022 and the impugned order was passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had wrongly noted the date as 8.6.2022. He further submits that earlier the matter was adjourned as there was restricted court working due to COVID-19 situation. He submits that the trial is fixed for 6.7.2022 and the petitioner would surrender before the trial court on the date fixed.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana appearing on advance notice accepts the same and opposes the prayer made in the petition. She submits that the petitioner was intentionally delaying the trial.

There is no dispute that it was the first default of the petitioner. Without commenting on the explanation put forth, considering the facts and circumstances in totality and to ensure that there is no further delay in the

trial, let the petitioner surrender before the trial court on 6.7.2022. On his surrender, the petitioner shall be released on bail on the bonds already furnished. The trial court would be at liberty to impose further conditions if deemed necessary to ensure the presence of the petitioner during the trial.

The petition is disposed of.
