The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.107 dated 04.06.2021 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 22.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Short reply has been filed on behalf of the respondent-State by the learned State counsel by way of an affidavit of Manmohan Singh Aulakh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Majitha, Amritsar and the same is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Yashpal Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position as also the fact that gunshot injury has been attributed to another co-accused and the petitioner has joined investigation, the interim order dated 22.06.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
