The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No.134 dated 24.07.2020, under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code and Section 13 of Punjab Travel Professional Regulation Act, registered at Police Station Khamano, District Fatahgarh Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case. It is submitted that in terms of order dated 07.09.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has also handed over an amount of Rs.1,50,000/- to the Investigating Officer. Apart from that, the matter stands compromised between the parties.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not

required for the custodial interrogation. It is also submitted that the order dated 07.09.2021 has been complied with by the petitioner.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 07.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
