On 29.06.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C in FIR No.36 dated 28.05.2022 under Section 306, 34 IPC, Police Station Bajakhana, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and even as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner's name has been introduced only by mentioning that the husband of deceased Kuldeep Kaur allegedly told her that he will get divorce from her and marry the petitioner. It is further submitted that the petitioner is Gurpreet Singh's first cousin, being daughter of his maternal aunt (Massi). She is married and settled in her own nuclear family. Admittedly, the husband of the deceased namely Gurpreet Singh was at his place of posting i.e. a place away from his home, as he stated to be serving in the Indian Army, for more than two months prior to the date of the incident.

Notice of motion for 22.08.2022.

Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, A.A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. He seeks and is granted time to file the status report.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join the investigation and would associate as and when called and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to ad interim bail on her furnishing personal bond and surety to the satisfaction of

Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that in pursuance of interim directions, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

On instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, learned State counsel also submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 29.06.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

The petition is allowed.
