The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for the issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct an enquiry upon the representation dated 12.11.2018 and to take appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 to 6 after registration of the FIR.

None appears on behalf of the petitioner. Similar was the situation on the last date of hearing.

The learned counsel for the State on instructions from SI Rajpal submits that as per the status report dated 13/22.02.2019, the post-mortem of the deceased Rai Mal was conducted by the Medical Board of General Hospital at Hisar. After the post-mortem, the Medical Board handed over the viscera of deceased Rai Mal which was sent to the Chemical Examiner, Karnal for examination. Based on the report, the investigating agency sought the opinion from the Doctor and thereafter, has come to the conclusion that no FIR needs to be registered in the present case.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
