1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P-1 dated 29.03.2019 in CWP No.8497 of 2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 29.03.2019 reveals that CWP-8497-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 17.01.2019 submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order thereon as expeditiously as possible.

3. Learned Counsel contends that the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondent to do the needful but after issuance of notice, the respondent has passed order dated 30.12.2020, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 30.12.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

learned counsel for the petitioner, no action is called for against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

5. Accordingly, the instant petition is disposed of as such with the liberty as prayed for.
