This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate writ, order or directions, especially in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the charge of inappropriate relationship from the impugned charge-sheet dated 14.06.2022 (Annexure P-13), wherein the petitioner has been charged for the same under Section 45 of the Army Act, 1950; with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

A perusal of the paper book and claim of the petitioner itself shows that the procedure being undertaken by the respondents against the petitioner is in accordance with the statutory provisions and procedure. The Court; at this stage of enquiry; is not required to interfere in the statutory procedure. Hence, finding the present petition to be totally premature, the same is dismissed.
