The instant Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to protect the life and personal liberty of the petitioner and also directing the respondents No. 4 and 5 not to interfere in the personal life and liberty of the petitioner and further directing the respondents No. 2 and 3 not to allow/let the respondents No. 4 and 5 or anybody else to interfere with the life and liberty of the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
