Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.307 dated 5.7.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 34, 364-A, 379-A, 379-B, 388, 389, 506 IPC at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the petitioner was not named in the FIR and was nominated as accused on the basis of disclosure statement made by co-accused Pooja @ Mannu who after her arrest was found to be innocent by the police.

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-accused Virender, Sonu @ Sohan Lal and Manish who were arrested by the police are already facing trial and during trial, the complainant and PW4-Mukesh Kumar have not supported the case of the prosecution. He further submits that the petitioner who was given concession of interim bail by the

Coordinate Bench of this Court vide previous order has already joined the

investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from ASI Ram Parkash has not refuted the fact that the petitioner has already joined investigation and further submits that the petitioner is not required by the police for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.6.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
