At the out set, the learned State counsel has submitted on instructions from ASI Yashpal that in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court on 09.07.2019 the petitioner has joined investigation and he has cooperated with the investigation process and he is not required for custodial interrogation. He further submitted that although the petitioner was earlier declared as a proclaimed person in the present case but thereafter in pursuance of the orders passed by this Court the petitioner has joined investigation.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at the time of the filing of the present petition he was not aware of the P.O. Proceedings and be that as it may since the petitioner has already surrendered and joined and the petitioner is not required for custodial

interrogation, the order dated 09.07.2019 may be confirmed.

In view of the aforesaid factual position that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and as per the learned State counsel, he is not required for custodial interrogation, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.07.2019 is hereby made absolute.
