Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Vide order dated 24.06.2022, the Superintendent of Police, Palwal was directed to look into the matter and to furnish a report and to take appropriate steps to assess the threat perception.

Today, on resumed hearing a status report by way of an affidavit of Yashpal Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3 has been filed. Same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been furnished to the learned counsel for the petitioners.

As per averments contained in the said affidavit the petitioner

No.1 has voluntarily accompanied her cousin and has come to the house of

her Mama. It is further submitted that the petitioners were not ordinarily residing at the address, which they have mentioned in the present petition and that they had come for a short period of 15 days and resided at the said address to file the present petition.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition.

Dismissed as not pressed.
