1. The prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in case of FIR No. 269, dated 26th April, 2022, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 324 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 added later on) registered at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

2. The brief facts are that on 26th April, 2022, petitioner-Anurag along with accomplice went to Moon Light Party Hall. On objection by the staff against consumption of liquor in the said premises an altercation took place. There is a CCTV footage of the incident. The role attributed to the petitioner is that he was present at the spot and he assaulted the complainant. Co-accused gave a knife blow on the thigh of the complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is in custody since 28th April, 2022 and investigation is complete. He Further submits that no recovery was made from the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel opposes the prayer for grant of regular bail and submits that petitioner was actively involved in the incident. He is

visible in the CCTV footage assaulting the complainant and he is involved in two more FIRs.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the nature of the allegations against the petitioner and the fact that knife blow is attributed to the co-accused, albeit, the investigation is complete conclusion of the trial is likely to take time and petitioner has no criminal antecedents, the petitioner is granted bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.

6. The petition is allowed.

7. It is clarified that observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
