The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.39 dated 27.09.2018 registered under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC at Police Station Kurali City, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

On 04.02.2020 this Court had passed the following order: -

“Prayer made in this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.39 dated 27.09.2018 under Sections 406 and 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Kurali City, District SAS Nagar (Mohali).

As per report received from the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, the parties failed to arrive at an amicable settlement. Adjourned to 05.05.2020.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation and appear before the investigating agency as and when required. In the event of his arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.PC.”

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance to the afore quoted order the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In the light of the fact that the dispute between the parties emanates from a matrimonial dispute and because the petitioner has joined the investigation, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioner's custodial interrogation is not necessary and therefore, the order of this Court dated 04.02.2020, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute.
