The petitioner had applied for re-issuance of the passport but his file was closed as he had not revealed the registration of an FIR against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not been challaned in the FIR and thus, refusal to re-issue a passport is illegal.

In view of the fact that the earlier application has been closed, the petitioner may apply afresh disclosing all the relevant facts. The fresh application shall be considered by the passport authorities in accordance with law.
