AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

An affidavit of the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra dated 04.05.2022, has been filed in Court, which is taken on record. Explanation which has been projected in the said affidavit is not acceptable, however, in the light of the fact that an unconditional apology has been tendered by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Kurukshetra and has also come present in person in the Court, this Court is not inclined to take further action against the deponent for non-compliance of the order passed by this Court. He states that four months time, from 11.05.2022 the date fixed in the case before him, would be required to finalize the proceedings pending before him. This period is being sought as there are around 85 respondents in the application/petition, who are alleged to be the encroachers.

Keeping in view the statement made by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Collector, Kurukshetra, who is present in the Court in person, we dispose of the writ petition taking the statement of the Deputy Commissioner on record. It would be open to the petitioner to revive the writ petition in case the proceedings are not concluded within the time as stated by the Deputy Commissioner for taking further action if required.

The present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
