The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.01 dated 09.01.2019 under Section 406, 498-A, 420, 120-B IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Women Cell District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that FIR in question emanates from a matrimonial dispute between the parties. He further submits that subsequent to the registration of FIR in question, parties have arrived at an amicable settlement and the complainant has returned to her matrimonial home. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 14.10.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harish Kumar does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined the investigation. He, on further instructions states that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 14.10.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
