Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.388 dated 05.05.2022, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 354-A, 452, 427, 506 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station City Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar.

Vide order dated 24.06.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner. On the last date of hearing, he had argued that the investigating agencies are intentionally favouring the accused. This Court vide order dated 09.11.2022 had given direction to the State to file affidavit.

Learned State counsel has placed on record the affidavit of Mr. Kanwaljeet Singh, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Yamuna Nagar wherein, it has been mentioned that the CCTV footage as alleged by counsel for the complainant are duly recovered and certificate under Section 65-B of the Evidence Act has also been obtained. It is shown in the CCTV footage that the petitioner had participated in the commission of offence.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Bhupinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. Investigating Officer is also present in person who has submitted that the investigation is being conducted without any bias and the same would be completed expeditiously.

Heard. In view of the above, interim order dated 24.06.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
