Since the main case is fixed for today, the present application for preponing the date of hearing in the main case is rendered infructuous.

Main case

This petition is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 85 dated 27.5.2020, under Sections 22, 29, 61 NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City 1, Malerkotla, District Sangrur, Punjab.

Recovery was of commercial quantity from the petitioner. One of the main ground for seeking regular bail was that there was no progress in the trial.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Janak Raj submits that there are total seventeen prosecution witnesses, mostly are the police officials and earnest efforts would be made to examine the prosecution witnesses within six months from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.
