The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and not to interfere in her peaceful life at the behest of respondent Nos.4 to 6 their other friends and relatives.

On the last date of hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioner had submitted that a number of documents of the petitioner were lying in the custody of her parents i.e. respondent Nos.4 and 5 and the same may be handed over to her.

The learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 had submitted that they had no objection in handing over the said documents to the petitioner.

In view of the undertaking given, today, the learned counsel for the respondent Nos.4 and 5 has handed over the following documents to the counsel for the petitioner:-

5. X Class Marksheet.
6. XII Class Marksheet
7. Passport.
8. Haryana Resident Certificate (photocopy)
she has lost her original Aadhar Card and
Haryana Resident Certificate.
9. Date of Birth Certificate.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has examined the said documents and is satisfied with the same.

The learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 submits that they shall not cause any interference in the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
