Matter has been settled *inter se* the parties and counsel for the Insurance Company has placed on record photocopy of demand draft dated 22.03.2022 bearing No. 083840 for a sum of Rs.1,20,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Twenty Thousand) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Mr. Vivek Suri, Advocate for the appellants, who is available through tele conferencing, has confirmed the said fact. Mr. Rajbir Singh, counsel for the Insurance Company has no objection if the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 for condonation of delay of 137 days in filing the appeal is allowed.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal alongwith the application for condonation of delay in terms of the settlement.

The above said demand draft be brought before the Registrar of Lok Adalat, so that the counsel for the claimants can collect the same. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the draft to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)/counsel for the appellant (s) may collect the draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.
