HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that in the year 2018, the services of the petitioner were regularized w.e.f. 2011 whereas, the petitioner was entitled for regularization of his services w.e.f. the year 2003/2004 keeping in view the regularization policy issued in the year 2003/2004 regarding the part time employees. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the basis of the said claim was that there were enough regular sanctioned posts in the District concerned in the year 2003/2004 so as to accommodate the petitioner for regularization of her services.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in view the reply filed, even the regularization granted to the petitioner w.e.f.

the year 2011 has been sought to be withdrawn after issuance of the show cause notice and the said order is not under challenge in the present petition and therefore, once, the petitioner has been found entitled for regularization from the year 2018, claim as raised in the present petition is liable to be rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the respondents have issued the said show cause notice during the pendency of the present petition, proposing even to withdraw the benefit of regularization of services granted to the petitioner w.e.f. the year 2011, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the said order/show cause notice along with the grievance that the recovery, if any which is being done from the petitioner in pursuance to the said order, is arbitrary and illegal.

Ordered accordingly.
