The present petition has been filed with a prayer that the petitioner had made a request to respondent No.2 to transfer the route permits, which was issued in the name of his brother, who unfortunately died but, the said request of the petitioner is still pending consideration with the respondent No.2 despite issuance of a legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P/6).

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner submits that he has instructions to submit that the petitioner will be satisfied, at the stage in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P/6) served by the petitioner by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel submits that in case legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P/6) served by the petitioner has not already been decided by the respondents, an appropriate order on the same will be passed

within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 14.03.2019 (Annexure P/6) served by the petitioner, if not already decided, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
