ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directing the respondents for registration of FIR or to file status report regarding investigation in the case.

Learned State counsel has filed the Status Report and submits that inquiry qua the complaint of the petitioner is in progress. He further submits that the present petition rendered infructuous in view of the status report as grievance of the petitioner stand redressed.

Confronted with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to withdraw this petition with the liberty to file a fresh petition in case any grievance exists. He further submits that since the enquiry is going on, the State may be requested to conclude it in a limited time period.
