The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.3 and 4.

Learned counsel for the State has pointed out that the petitioners are involved in two FIRs i.e. FIR No.119 dated 19.04.2022 under Sections 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and FIR No.155 dated 05.06.2022 registered under Sections 323 and 324 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternative appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
