This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari quashing of the termination order (Annexure P-12) dated 26.04.2022 passed by respondent No.3, whereby petitioner was illegally removed by the respondents from his job; as also seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents not to remove the petitioner from his job; and as also seeking directions to the respondents to allow the petitioner to continue on his job and not to recruit any other person for the said job, during the pendency of the writ petition.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rohit Verma, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

It is pointed out by the learned counsel for the respondents that the subject matter involved in the present petition falls under the jurisdiction of the Central Administrative Tribunal.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy before the Central Administrative Tribunal.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
