Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No.90 dated 08.08.2018 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, however, Section 376 IPC has been added later on, at P.S.Sadar, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala (Annexure P-1), on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-4).

Upon instructions from ASI Jinder Lal, State counsel submits that petitioner No.2, who is a juvenile, has been acquitted by Juvenile Justice Board, Kapurthala. He submits that petitioner No.1 has already been acquitted and this fact has been recorded in the order dated 23.10.2019

passed by this Court.

Faced with this development, counsel for the petitioners submits that instant petition has become infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
