Prayer in this writ petition *inter alia* is for setting aside orders dated 06.12.2021, Annexure P-7, passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Ambala (respondent no.1), whereby petition under Section 13-B of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 (for short 'the Act'), filed by the private respondents has been allowed as well as 01.06.2022, Annexure P-10, passed by respondent no.1 ordering stay of auction proceedings.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that this writ petition is rendered infructuous pursuant to passing of order dated 11.07.2022 deciding the revision petition filed by private respondents No. 6, 8, 10, 11, 13 to 22 and 24 to 28, by the Commissioner Ambala. He however, seeks

liberty to the petitioner to challenge the same before the appropriate forum.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.

Needless to say, petitioner is at liberty to challenge order dated 11.07.2022, in accordance with law.
