This is a first petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR no.124 dated 08.06.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325, 506, 148, 149 and 452 IPC (added later on) at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa.

On 28.06.2022, a coordinate Bench of this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-

“Notice of motion.

On asking, Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice and seeks time to have instructions.

In the meanwhile, petitioner shall join investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer shall admit him to interim bail in the present case till next date of hearing upon furnishing adequate bail/surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioner is also directed to abide by all the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
