Petitioner-Jagjit Singh is seeking regular bail in case of FIR No.147 dated 3.11.2017, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 20, District Panchkula.

On 22nd July, 2019, the following order was passed:

"Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner reiterates what he had stated on the last date of hearing, to the effect that the petitioner would go before all the authorities to obtain the necessary certificate to enable the transfer of the flat in question to the complainant.

Consequently, upon the petitioner furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula, he shall be admitted to interim bail till the next date of hearing fixed before this Court, during which time he would obtain all the necessary certificate and ensure that the flat in question is transferred.

Adjourned to 26.08.2019."

The matter was referred to Mediation. The petitioner till date is on interim bail.

As per Mediation report, the parties have amicably settled the matter.

There are no allegations that the interim bail was misused, the petitioner is granted regular bail on the surety bond already furnished.

The petition is allowed.

It is clarified that the observations made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
