As per reply filed by the State, it appears that the matter has already been compromised between the private parties.

However, today, counsel for the petitioners submits that no such compromise has been effected between the parties.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection to their life and liberty from the hands of respondents No.4 to 6 who are unnecessarily harassing the petitioners and in this regard, the petitioners had given representation/ complaint dated 4.8.2020 (Annexure P-2).

The present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation (Annexure P-2) and in case any threat perception is found, then to provide necessary protection to the

petitioners if situation so warrants. However, in case the petitioners or private respondents have committed any offence, then the authorities are at liberty to take action against them as per law.
