Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.54 dated 30.03.2022 under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind.

As per the allegations in the FIR, on receipt of secret information, the petitioner was apprehended riding the motorcycle bearing registration No. HR-10K-8630. 445 grams of charas has been recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is in custody since 30.03.2022. The recovery effected from the petitioner is non-commercial. The investigation in the case is complete and challan has already been filed. Though there are seven other cases pending against the petitioner, however, none of them is under NDPS Act.

In view of the above and the fact that the trial is unlikely

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to conclude in near future, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Therefore, in view of the abovesaid circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed. Petitioner-Sanjay be admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court concerned.
