1. The learned State counsel, on instructions given to her by ASI Satpal Singh, submits, that the trial arising out of FIR No. 0095 of 30.7.2018, registered at Police Station Doraha, District Ludhiana, has resulted in a verdict of conviction, becoming recorded by the learned trial Judge concerned, qua the charges drawn against the accused concerned.
2. Consequently, the instant petition, claiming therein relief of transfer of investigations to an agency other than the one, earlier holding probe therein, becomes rendered infructuous.
