1. This petition is filed seeking directions to the official respondents to protect life and liberty of the petitioner and his mother as Station House Officer, Police Station Tanda, district Hoshiarpur was harassing the petitioner and his family members at the behest of respondent No.5. Further prayer is conducting impartial investigation in FIR No. 81, dated 22nd April, 2022, registered at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur.

2. Learned State counsel filed a reply, same is taken on record.
Copy supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Para 7 of the reply quoted below:-

“That it is submitted that the petitioner has levelled false and frivolous allegations against the answering respondent regarding harassment and the same are vehemently denied. The answering respondent never harassed the petitioner and his family members as alleged in the present petition. The petitioner and other family members of the petitioner are not required in the present case. The police of P.S. Tanda are conducting fair and proper investigation in the present case.”

4. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner is son of Gulam Rasul who is an accused in FIR No. 81 and was arrested on 22nd April, 2022.
5. In view of the pleadings in para 7 of the reply, petitioner is not required in any case, hence, no further directions are called for. The petition is disposed of.
6. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law so far as the prayer for fair and impartial investigation of the FIR is concerned.
