The petitioners through instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.c. is seeking direction to official respondents to conduct an enquiry and register case against the private respondents.

As per reply dated 08.12.2020 of the State, the enquiry officer called both the parties. The petitioners accepted that there is no harassment on the part of the police. In the enquiry, it was found that local police had never harassed the petitioners on any account and it is case of two groups in the village. No case has been registered against the petitioners.
