The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 97 dated 09.06.2022 under Sections 379, 473 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 411 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

A perusal of the impugned order would show that it is specifically mentioned that the petitioner is involved in two other cases.

Learned State counsel has also stated that the petitioner is involved in two other cases. However, in paragraph 16 of the present petition, it has been stated that the petitioner is involved in one more case.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh petition after giving particulars of both the FIRs and also the fact as to whether he has been granted bail in the said cases or not.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
