Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 31.05.2022 (P-2). Further prayer is for directing the official respondents to pass the speaking order on the representation dated 13.06.2022 (P-3).

At the outset, learned Counsel on instructions from the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case the representation dated 13.06.2022 (P-3) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2 and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the above, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the claim of the petitioner, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 13.06.2022 (P-3) by passing reasoned order as per law within one week from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case there is a failure on the part of competent authority, petitioner would be at liberty to move an appropriate application for revival of this writ petition and the same shall be considered as per law.
