Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.95 dated 26.05.2022, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Fatehgarh Sahib, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Vide order dated 30.06.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 30.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He also submits that he had handed over a demand draft of Rs.30,000/- bearing No.005268 dated 11.07.2022 towards the litigation expenses. However, Mr. Simranjeet Singh, brother of the complainant who is present in the Court, has requested to the Court that the draft is in the name of Manjot

Kaur wife of Daljit Singh, however, the bank account of respondent No.2 is by the name of Manjot Kaur daughter of Gurmeet Singh. He submits that in view of the technicalities, the said draft is not being accepted by the Bank and the same be given in the name of Manjot Kaur daughter of Gurmeet Singh. The draft has been handed over to counsel for the petitioner who has candidly acknowledged that he would handover a fresh demand draft in the name of Manjot Kaur daughter of Gurmeet Singh within seven days from today to the investigating officer for onward transmission of the same to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner regarding affirming of interim bail.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Supinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 30.06.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
