GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.148 dated 20.03.2020 registered at Police Station Sector 32-33, Karnal, under Sections 120-B/406/420 IPC (Sections 467/468/471/506/201 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 04.08.2021, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners, namely, Ranjit Singh and Vimal @ Arvind and also

of complainant Sultan Singh have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The complainant Sultan Singh in his statement has stated that he has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily and without any coercion or pressure.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.148 dated 20.03.2020 registered at Police Station Sector 32-33, Karnal, under Sections 120-B/406/420 IPC (Sections 467/468/471/506/201 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
