Present petition is under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 247 dated 27.05.2022, registered under Sections 147/149/323/354/379/452 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

On 01.07.2022, the following order was passed:-

Allowed as prayed for.

Documents at Annexures P-1 to P-12, are taken on record.

Main case

Notices served upon the official respondent(s) through the State's counsel.

Given the nature of allegations, instructions/status report/response is required from the State, for which the State seeks time.

Consequently, in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on interim bail, subject to furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

List on 04.07.2022, along with CRM-M-27648-2022.

It is made clear that the interim order shall continue till the next date only.”

interim directions, the petitioners have been released on interim bail and they have also joined the investigation.

On instructions from Inspector Lalit Kumar, learned State counsel has not assailed the aforesaid factual aspects and states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

It has been further stated that the status report or response is not to be submitted in the instant case.

In view of the aforesaid submissions, the order dated 29.06.2022, granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.
