The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.247 dated 04.04.2022 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 294, 323, 324, 506 IPC, 1860 (Sections 325 and 326 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.06.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Shailender Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.06.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
