ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The petitioner who was one of the three accused, had come up before this Court seeking quashing of the FIR on the grounds that two accused who were convicted by the trial Court and had compromised the matter at the Sessions Court with the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after taking all the benefits, the complainant has backed out of the compromise. He further submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh after persuading the complainant .

Prayer is accepted.

Petition is disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner files a fresh petition, withdrawal of the present petition shall not come in the way of filing of fresh petition. It is also permissible for the petitioner to file a petition for quashing on merits.
