The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.79 dated 14.05.2022 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 201 IPC at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

By virtue of the order dated 05.07.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He has submitted that the matter has also been amicably resolved.
