MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.402 dated 02.07.2021 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 13.08.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner and the complainant were already having a dealing relating to wooden doors etc., and for the said purpose a sum of approximately Rs. 1,00,000/- was received in petitioner's account. He submits that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation, therefore, in the given facts his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

Adjourned to 03.12.2021.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The

petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Surender Singh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 13.08.2021 is made absolute.
