The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 216 dated 02.07.2019, registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 302, 303, 506, 452, 120-B of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that he has instructions to say that the petitioners will face the trial and will not challenge the summoning order dated 18.02.2022, wherein they have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners have already filed a petition before this Court, bearing CRM-M-9369-2022, challenging the aforesaid summoning order, however, they will not press the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is present in

Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not dispute the fact that the petitioners were declared innocent during investigation and now they have been summoned as additional accused under Section 319 Cr.P.C.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without making any comment on the merits of the case, in order to avoid any further delay in disposal of the trial, the present petition is allowed. The petitioners are directed to appear before the trial Court on or before 20.07.2022 and on doing so, the trial Court will release them on bail, subject to their furnishing bail/surety bonds to its satisfaction.

Till the time the petitioners appear before the trial Court, their arrest shall remain stayed.
