Petitioners have assailed the order dated 02.07.2016 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patiala and judgment dated 13.02.2017 passed by the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Patiala vide which petitioner No.1 has been granted interim maintenance @ Rs.2500/- per month in the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the respondent contends that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties, the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C has been disposed of and the marriage of the parties has been dissolved by a decree of divorce by mutual consent under Section 13-B of Hindu Marriage Act. Consequently, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of two months, in the event, the aforesaid assertion is found to be factually incorrect.
