Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.48 dated 24.05.2022 registered under Sections 323, 324, 325, 326, 336, 365, 148 and 149 of IPC read with Sections 25 and 27 Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Qila Lal Singh, District Batala.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that both the petitioners were not named in the FIR and later on impleaded as accused on the basis of supplementary statement of Harpreet Singh @ Goldy. Counsel for the petitioners further submits that no specific injury has been attributed to the petitioners and they have joined the investigation with the Police by virtue of the previous order dated 26.07.2022, whereby, both of them have been granted interim bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court.

The State Counsel on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by the counsel for the petitioners.

State Counsel further submits that both the petitioners who have joined the investigation are not required by the Police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation and recoveries have been effected from both the petitioners.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is allowed and the order of interim bail dated 06.07.2022 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court is made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
