Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110 dated 02.07.2021, under Section 498-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Pathankot.

Vide order dated 04.08.2021 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 04.08.2021, petitioner has joined the investigation and appeared before the Mediation Centre as well, however, the same remained unsuccessful and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 also affirms the fact that the parties appeared before the Mediation Centre. However, he submits that negotiations remained unsuccessful because of the adamant attitude of the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, affirmed the fact that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the attending circumstances, the matter needs to be investigated and case be decided on merits. Accordingly, interim order dated 04.08.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
