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KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case having FIR No. 73 dated 14.07.2017 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC at P.S. Arniwala, District Fazilka.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation with the police in the light of the order dated 25.02.2022 passed by this Court and they have also deposited an amount of Rs. 3,00,000/- (rupees three lakhs only) in total with the Bank out of the loan amount.

3. Status report by way of affidavit of Palwinder Singh Sandhu, PPS Deputy Superintendent of Police Sub Division, Jalalabad District Fazilka, on

behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

4. The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Manjeet Singh has not disputed the aforesaid assertions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners. The State counsel has further submitted that after completion of investigation the *challan* is presented against the petitioners in the Court concerned and now the petitioners are not required by the police for any further investigation or custodial interrogation.

5. In the light of the above without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is hereby allowed and order of interim bail dated 25.02.2022 is hereby made absolute. However the petitioners are directed to abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
