Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 & 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that without any reason, petitioners No.1 to 5, who are minor sons and daughters of one Mohammed Sharif, are being harassed by the police by visiting their house and petitioner No.6 Mohammdeen is the person, under whose care, they are living. It is further submitted that uncle of the petitioners, namely Gama was taken in custody by the police.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Joginder Pal Ratra, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from SHO, Police Station Sadar Dhuri, submits that in fact, one complaint was received in police station that one Bano ran away with father of petitioners No.1 to 5, namely Mohd. Sharif and in this regard, ASI Sher Singh went to their house with regard to investigation/inquiry of the said complaint and neither the petitioners are required by the police nor Gama, uncle of the petitioners is in illegal custody of the police.

Learned State counsel further submits that in case the petitioners are required for any investigation, the police will give an advance notice in writing to them.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, this petition is disposed of and it is made clear that in case the petitioners are required for any investigation, they will be given an advance notice in writing for the said purpose.
