Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.17, dated 16.02.2022, registered under Sections 452, 395, 380, 354-B, 148, 149, 323, 427 IPC (Sections 201 and 379-B IPC added vide Rapat No.13 dated 18.02.2022 and Rapat No.24 dated 03.05.2022, respectively), at Police Station Bariwala, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

By virtue of the order dated 01.07.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gur Iqbal Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and submitted that they are no more required for further investigation. He further submits that the investigation is complete and challan is also filed.

In view of the above, the order dated 01.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
